

Limited Lifetime Warranty

POWER TRAIN COVERAGE

For original owners (defined below), the Power Train Limited Warranty begins upon expiration of manufacturer original warranty. It does not cover normal wear and tear, maintenance or those items excluded elsewhere in this document see "Exceptions" and "What Not Covered is".

The warranty applies only to those vehicles 2005 or newer to the current model year at the time of purchase.

The items covered by the Power Train Limited Warranty Include:

Engine: Cylinder block, cylinder head and all internal parts, timing gear, seals and

gaskets, valve cover, flywheel, oil pump and water pump

Transmission case and all internal parts, torque converter, drive shafts,

universal joints, front hubs, bearings, seals and gaskets

Axles: Axle shafts and seats, hub and wheel bearings

Transmission: Transmission case, transfer case, torque converter and all internal parts, seals

and gaskets

Differentials: Front and rear differential assemblies, cases, all internal parts, seals and

gaskets

Propeller Shafts: Universal joints

All the items not specific are covered

ORIGINAL OWNER

An original owner is defined as the first retail purchaser of the vehicle sold by the Car Factory Outlet.

VEHICLES PLACED IN COMMERCIAL SERVICE

The limited Lifetime Warranty excludes all coverage from any vehicle that has been places into any form of commercial service, including, but not limited to taxi, route delivery, livery service or rental and or any type of cargo service.



YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN YOUR WARRANTY

MAINTENANCE:

You are responsible for properly operating and maintaining your vehicle every 3 months or 3,000 miles. If your vehicle is used under sever driving conditions, the warranty is void.

You should retain all maintenance records; they will be necessary to prove that all required maintenance has been performed. Keep all receipts and make them available in the event they are needed to verify service performed and provided.

All maintenance must be performed at its manufacturing dealer service department according to vehicle make.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED?

The following items are not covered.

- If your vehicle is used under service driving conditions, the warranty is voided

Damage due to factors include, but are not limited to:

- Misuse of the vehicle such as driving over curbs or into roadway maintenance or construction areas, overloading a vehicle, racing or engaging in activities or activities or uses not described in the owner manual
- Accidents and indigents that damage the vehicle, including but not limited to: Collision, fire, theft, riot, alteration, modification, tampering and rewiring
- Damage or collision from the environment such as acid rain, airborne fallout (chemicals, tree aspect), salt road hazards, hail, wind storm, lighting floods and acts of God.

DAMAGE DUE TO LACK OF MAINTENANCE OR THE USE OF WRONG FUEL, OIL OR LUBRICANTS

Improper maintenance or the use of other than specified fuel, oil or lubricants recommended in your owner's manual.

ALTERED MILEAGE

Any tampering or alteration of odometer or mileage reading will automatically void this warranty.

- The duration of the all implied warranties, if any, including but not limited the warranties of merchantability and fitness, are limited respectively to the duration of these express warranties
- These warranties are given in the lieu of all other expressed warranties (except any forth separately in this document) on the part of the Car Factory outlet shall not be liable for any economic loss, incidental, special, consequential or exemplary damages or any services not expressly provided for herein
